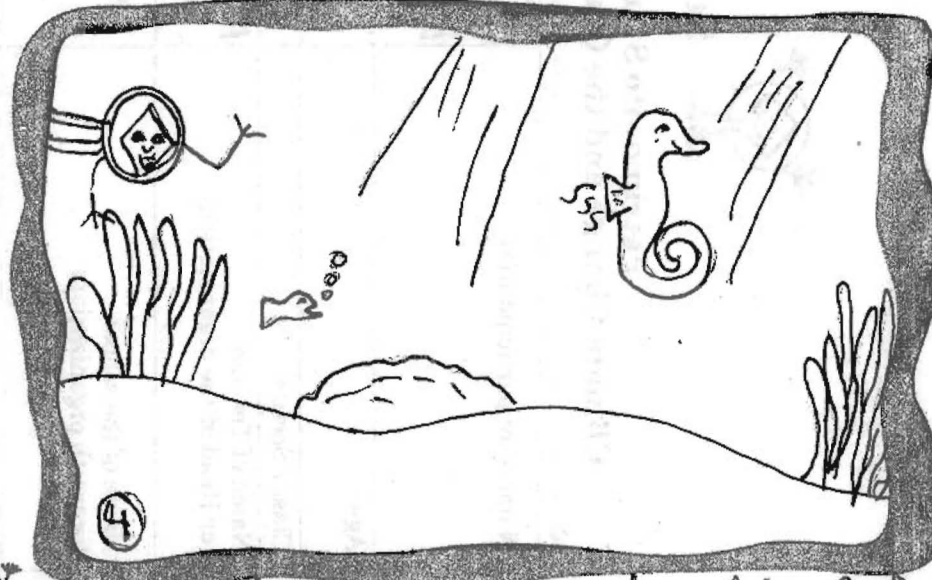
Patrimonito is visiting the Great Barrier Reef off the coast of Queensland, Australia.



Patrimonito is happily exploring the unique ecosystems of the Reef.



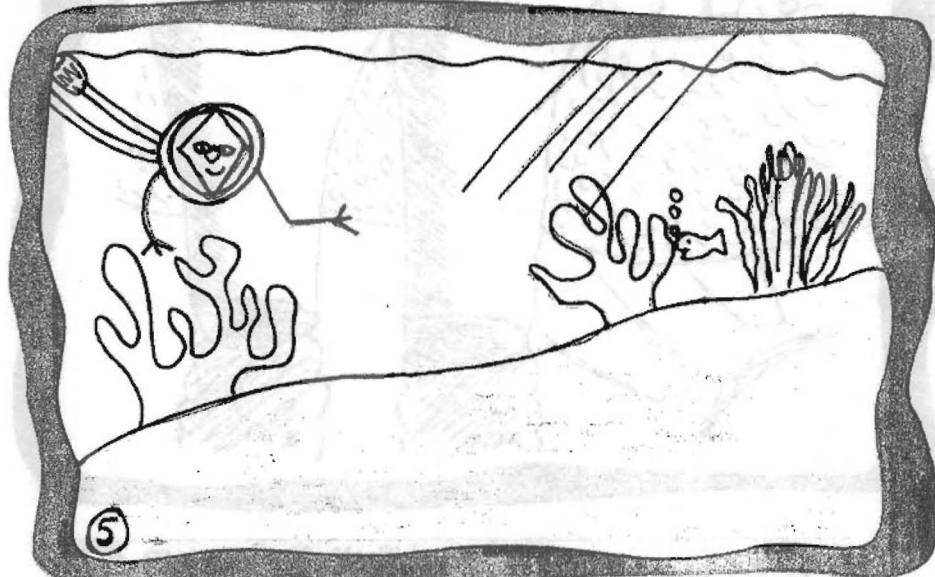
Patrimonito meets a forlorn little seahorse.



The seahorse takes Patrimonito on a tour of the Reef.

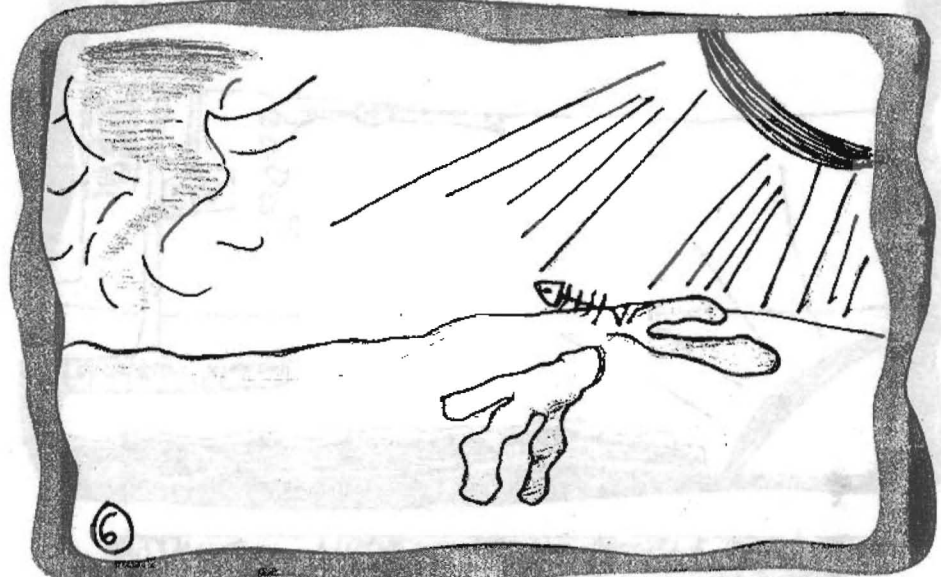

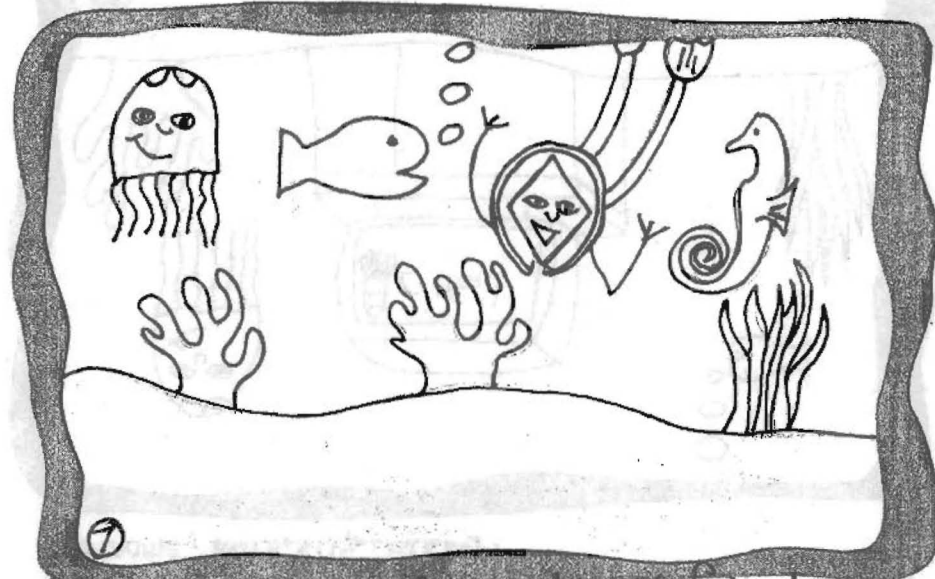

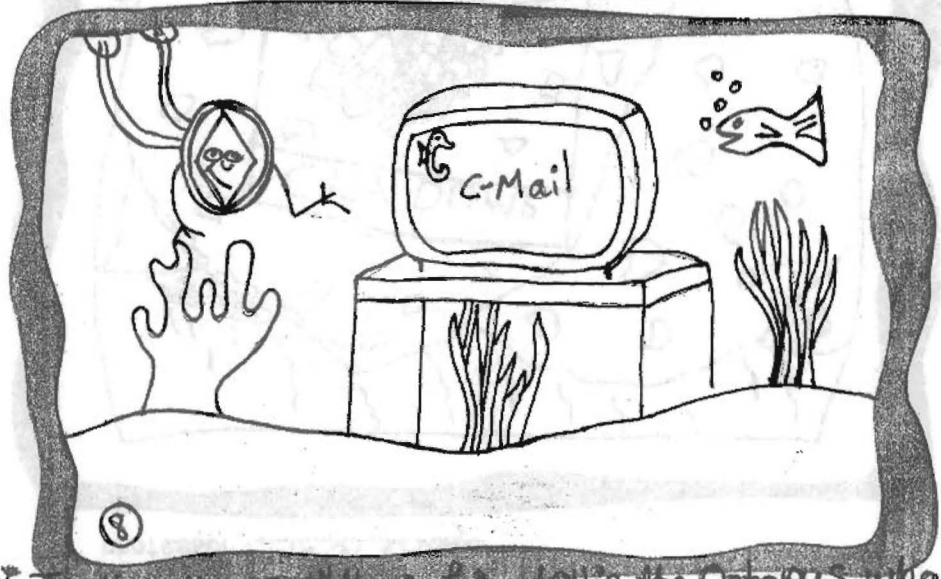

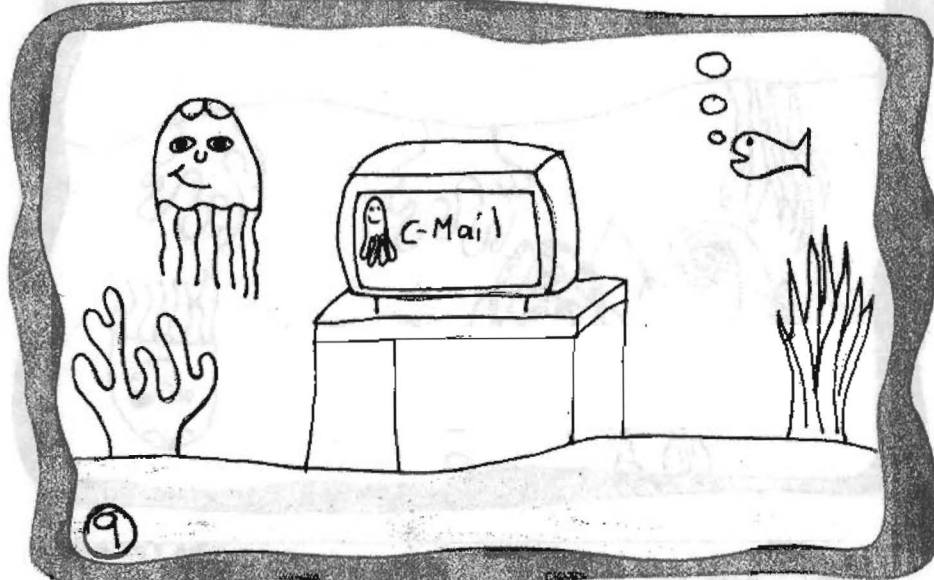

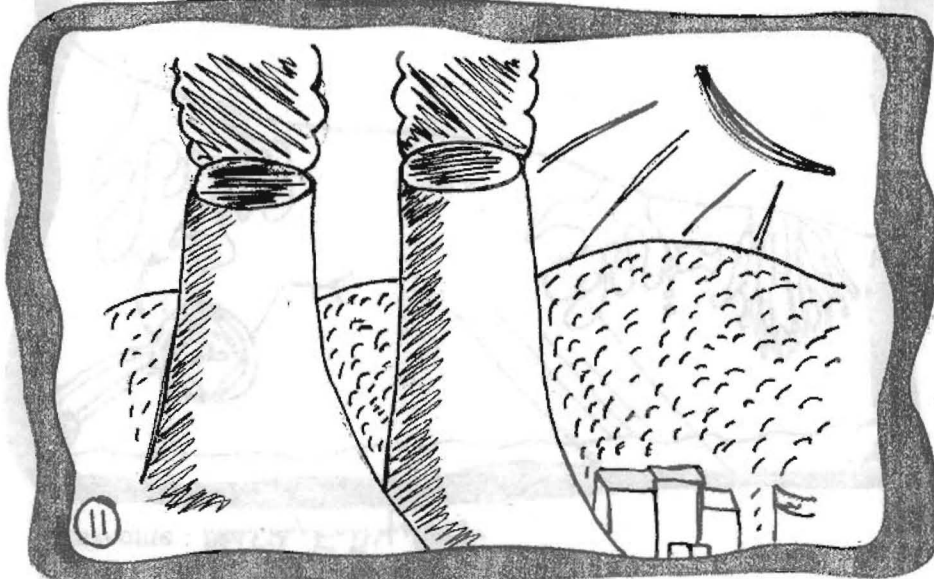

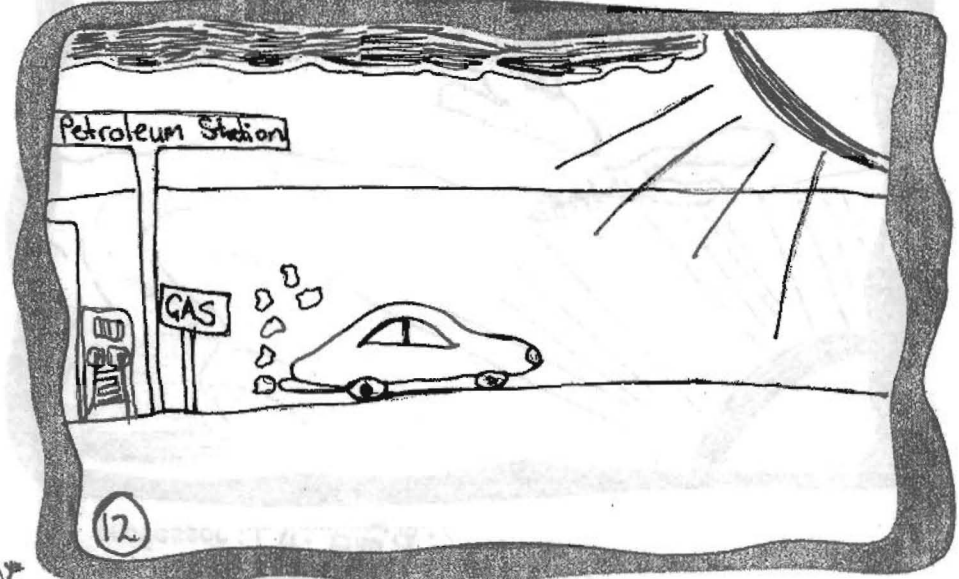
